Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Happy continuation of our Easter Season. The theme of this Sunday's readings is witness. The first witnesses to the resurrection of Jesus were, at first, at a loss as to what was happening—how Jesus, once crucified and buried, could be alive again. But the risen Jesus did not come to everyone, but only to those he designated as witnesses to proclaim, not only His resurrection, but the implication it has for all of us. This witness cost them all their lives, but so convincing was their testimony that nearly 2,000 years later you and I believe.

Therefore, we are today's witnesses. Unlike being a courtroom witness who gives mere verbal testimony, our Christian witness is more all-encompassing. How we treat others, the charities we choose to support, the way we grapple with how and for whom to vote, the moral choices we make, as well as our participation in the community and life of the Church all give witness to what we believe. St. Peter exhorts us to "be ready to give an explanation for our hope," should someone ask us why we live the way we do, and why we believe what we do. But first and foremost, we should be living our faith in such a way that if, God-forbid, we were ever dragged into court and accused of being a Christian, there would ample evidence to convict us.

Do we ever think about that? The "separation of church and state" means that no religious group can control the government, but it does not mean that we must only express our faith behind closed doors. "You are my witnesses," Jesus says, and in the gift of the Holy Spirit, we are empowered to be such, with every aspect of our lives. God bless, and have a great week.
