Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Happy “Good Shepherd” Sunday.

I read a statistic recently that was, at the same time, both distressing and encouraging. The statistic is this: Among American Catholics, 6.8% of parishioners contribute 80% of the parish’s resources; and 6.4% of parishioners are responsible for 80% of the volunteering that happens in parishes today. This is distressing, of course, from a justice standpoint. We’re *all* called, by virtue of our Baptism, to contribute our fair share to the carrying-out of the mission of our Church and parish family, to get involved to the extent of our ability, and not remain simply as consumers or sideline observers.

On the other hand, the amount of good that is done, the number of mouths that are fed, spirits that are lifted, souls that are nourished, and vulnerable people that are defended by the Church is, by far, one of the greatest and impactful sources of good in the world. That so much good could be done by less than 7% of us is staggering. Imagine the impact that 14% of us, or 20% of us, or more, could make!

Jesus, the Good Shepherd, not only anticipates and provides for our needs. He invites us to shepherd one another, to anticipate and care for the needs of other lost sheep so that they might be lost no longer. Imagine if each of us was as invested in Christ’s mission of shepherding to the extent that some 6.8% of us are. Then the whole world would cry out with conviction: “The Lord is my shepherd. And there is nothing that I lack.”
