

Dear Parishioners and Visitors,

Happy Fifth Sunday of Easter. This weekend we complete the Christian Initiation of four of the nine adults who have spent a year of their lives going to classes and growing in faith and understanding in order to become full members of the Catholic Church. All of these individuals were baptized, some as Roman Catholics, others in one of the non-Catholic Christian denominations, but none had yet been fully initiated such that, at the 11:00 Mass this Sunday, they will be Confirmed and be received at the Eucharistic table through First Holy Communion. Five of the nine were received into the Church at the Easter Vigil. The remaining four who will be received this week are Chelsey Seager, Danielle DiGiovanni, Chelsea Pisorn, and Joshua Wayne. Congratulations to them all!

What a blessing for our communities to be adding new members who, through the inspiration of the Holy Spirit, have discerned their way into the Church. As I have mentioned in various homilies, the state of the Church today resembles in many ways the cultural context of the first three centuries of Christianity when the Church was anything but mainstream and consisted of a small but extremely committed community of adults there through a conscious decision of their own, rather than being born into the faith. I heard a statistic recently that, in Europe, adult baptisms of Catholics now outnumber infant baptisms. While we may lament that parents are not bringing their children for baptism at the rate that we might be used to, yet the Church today, like the early Church, continues to add new members—members who have listened to the hunger of their hearts, heard the still small voice of God calling, have met the Risen Christ, and responded by choosing to become members of the Church in their adult years.
