This car is used by Fr. Raymond to obtain medical supplies for the Chauffard clinic. It also serves as an ambulance, taking sick villagers to a hospital in Port-au-Prince. Additionally, the car is needed to pick up food for the children's school lunches.

Thanks to the generosity of BEGECA, we can purchase a new Land Cruiser 4x4 13-seater for \$33,600, much less than its usual MSRP. This new car is vital to life in Chauffard.
