Frequently Asked Questions

1. What is the purpose of the Pastoral Council?

The purpose of the council is to meet the pastoral and spiritual needs of the parish. As an open forum of communication, we can assist our pastor through consensus.

2. Who belongs to the Council?

The council consists of our Pastor and Deacon, 12 at-large members of the parish (10 adult members, 2 youth members), the 2 parish trustees, a representative of the parish staff, and ex-officio members (i.e. a representative from Altar & Rosary committee, etc.). All members of the parish are welcomed to attend.

3. How are members elected?

Parish members may nominate themselves or another parish member (such as a spouse, young adult family member, friend, etc.). Members will be drawn anonymously at mass from the nominees.

4. What happens at the meeting?

Each meeting is opened and closed with prayer. The agenda, committee reports, items for discussion, etc. are emailed to each member in advance of the meetings. Each item on the agenda is reviewed and discussed.

5. What is my commitment?

At-large members are elected for a term of 2 years.

6. How much of my time will it require?

We meet 9 times a year in the rectory meeting room on the fourth Wednesday of the month for 60 to 90 minutes beginning at 7:00 pm and ending by 8:30 pm. The following are the tentative meeting dates for next year:
